Vendor Registration Information and Application Form

Welcome

Seminole Gaming operates Class III gaming activities under the authority of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act (IGRA) and applicable regulations established by the National Indian Gaming Commission (NIGC). As part of its regulatory and compliance obligations, Seminole Gaming conducts ongoing reviews of vendors and business transactions associated with its gaming operations to ensure compliance with all applicable laws, regulations, and internal requirements.

Companies interested in providing goods or services to Seminole Gaming must complete the Vendor Registration process and submit all required documentation for review. Only vendors with an approved registration status may be considered for future business opportunities related to Seminole Gaming operations.

Failure to provide the required information or maintain compliance with vendor registration requirements may result in the inability to participate in future bidding opportunities or conduct business with Seminole Gaming.

Registration Requirements

To begin the registration process, vendors must:

- Complete all required vendor registration forms.
- Submit all requested supporting documentation.
- Provide accurate and current business information.
- Pay the required vendor registration fee, if applicable.

Incomplete applications or missing documentation may delay processing and approval.

Vendor Registration Fee

A non-refundable application fee is required to review and process all vendor registrations.

- **Non-Gaming Vendors:** \$250
- **Gaming Vendors:** \$500

Payment of the registration fee does not guarantee approval as a registered vendor. Vendor approval is subject to the successful review and verification of all required information and documentation.



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Annual Renewal Requirements

- Approved vendors must maintain an active registration status to remain eligible for business opportunities with Seminole Gaming.
- An annual non-refundable renewal fee is required to support ongoing compliance and vendor record maintenance.

Failure to submit the renewal fee or provide requested updates may result in:

- Suspension of vendor status
- Inactivation of the vendor profile
- Removal from consideration for future business opportunities

Foreign Qualification Requirements

Companies organized outside the State of Florida may be required to provide proof of authorization to conduct business in Florida. If applicable, vendors should obtain a Certificate of Authority through the Florida Division of Corporations (Sunbiz): <https://www.sunbiz.org>.

A Certificate of Authority demonstrates that a business entity formed in another state has been authorized to transact business within Florida.

Important Notice

Submission of a vendor registration application does not:

- Guarantee approval as a registered vendor.
- Guarantee participation in any bidding process.
- Establish a contractual relationship with Seminole Gaming.
- Guarantee the award of business opportunities.

Seminole Gaming reserves the right to request additional documentation, perform due diligence reviews, or deny vendor registration in accordance with applicable policies and regulatory requirements.
